Subject: Procedure for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses in various Civil Hospitals running under Health Department and Government Medical Colleges in the state of Haryana for the Academic Session 2025-26.

1.	<p>The Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify the admission process for admission of Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses under State Quota seats for the academic session 2025-26 at various NBE accredited District Civil Hospitals running under Health Department and Government Medical Colleges in the State of Haryana.</p> <p>As per the guidelines of National Board of Examination (NBE), only 'Regular In-service Doctors' of Haryana Government are eligible for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses under State quota seats.</p>
2.	<p>It is notified that 50% of seats of Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma for the academic session 2025-26 at various NBE accredited District Civil Hospitals running under Health Department, shall be filled through All India Merit category of NEET PG 2025 and the remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled under State Quota at various NBE accredited District Civil Hospitals in the State of Haryana.</p> <p>It is further notified that 20% of seats in Post MBBS DNB, Post MBBS Diploma Courses in Government Medical Colleges shall be reserved for In-service candidates and filled up under State Quota. The remaining seats in Government Medical Colleges shall be filled up as All India Quota seats by MCC, DGHS, Government of India.</p> <p>The State Reservation policy shall be applicable for admission to all State Quota seats in various District Civil Hospitals and Government Medical Colleges.</p>

3.	<p>Admission shall be made in Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses in the following Institutes subject to the final approval from Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi/State Government/Affiliating University: -</p> <p>NBE accredited Civil Hospitals in the State of Haryana:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. District Civil Hospital, Ambala City 2. Civil Hospital, Ambala Cantt. 3. District Civil Hospital, Faridabad 4. District Civil Hospital, Gurugram 5. District Civil Hospital, Hisar 6. 4.	<p>Department of Medical Education & Research, Haryana has been authorized to conduct combined centralized counselling for State Quota seats of Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses along with counselling for admission to MD/MS courses for the academic session 2025-26 through Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak. The combined centralized counselling shall be on the basis of merit of NEET PG 2025.</p>
5.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) The tentative seat distribution of Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma presently in various District Civil Hospitals and Government Medical Colleges shall be available on the website of the University and the admission web portal. The seats in each specialty/Institute are subject to final approval from NBE. Accordingly, the final distribution of seats may vary depending upon the decision of National Board of Examination (NBE). b) The seat matrix for admission to above mentioned courses in District Civil Hospitals shall be provided by Health Department, Haryana.
6.	<p>It is further notified that all the students seeking admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses for the academic session 2025-26 shall have to get themselves registered online through authorized admission web portal which shall be duly published as well as uploaded on the admission web portal and on the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences Rohtak i.e. www.uhsr.ac.in and webportal of Department of MER.</p>
7.	<p>Eligibility criteria:-</p> <p>A candidate for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses in various District Civil Hospitals/Government Medical Colleges of the State shall be eligible if he/she :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Is a citizen of India; ii) Has passed MBBS examination from any Medical college /Institution recognized by National Medical Council and is in regular service of Haryana Government. iii) The candidate should be registered with the Haryana Medical Council/Any State Medical Council/Medical Council of India (MCI)/National Medical Commission (NMC). iv) The candidate should have completed his/her tenure of service and should obtain NOC as per PG Policy notified by Health Department, Haryana from time to time. v) An In-service doctor desirous of seeking admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses shall have to obtain No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their respective competent authority of the State Government Department including ESIC run hospitals, dispensaries, etc as per respective PG policy prevalent at that time. vi) All In-service doctors of Haryana desirous of seeking admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses in any category of seats should fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the information bulletin by NBE for the academic year 2025-26 issued from time to time.

	<p>vii) No candidate, who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified for NEET PG- 2025 shall be eligible for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses.</p> <p>Note.—The candidates, who have been provisionally allotted seats will have to bring in original, all the relevant certificates/documents at the time of document verification, without which admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses shall not be permitted. Attested photocopies of certificates/ documents will not be considered valid for the purpose of admission and the seats allocated to such candidates shall be cancelled.</p>
8.	Procedure for admission on the seats under State Quota for In-service doctors of Haryana
	i. The admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses under all State quota seats amongst all the registered 'In-service doctors' on admission web-portal will be made online on the basis of Haryana State merit list prepared as per the merit of NEET PG 2025 for Post MBBS DNB Degree, Post MBBS Diploma seats respectively.
	ii. A candidate who is already admitted to any Post Graduate MD/MS/DNB Degree/Diploma/Post Diploma Degree course is not eligible to apply for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses till the completion of respective course. An undertaking to this effect will be given by the candidate. Concealment of facts will invite disqualification without assigning any reason/ notice.
	iii. The In-service doctors desirous of seeking admission to Post MBBS DNB /Post MBBS Diploma courses for the academic session 2025-26 shall have to register online on the admission web portal. The in-service doctors shall register only once for admission to MD/ MS / DNB courses. The registration fee will be as specified by department of MER.
	iv. After commencement of PG course, if any in-service doctor having joined the institute, leaves the course after three days prior to the last date of admissions prescribed by the National Board of Examinations/MoHFW then; he/she shall be debarred for applying to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses under the State Quota seats, for the next three years.
	v. The schedule of document verification / admission and start of classes will be in conformity with the schedule laid down by National Board of Examinations/ MoHFW and State Government/ Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
	vi. Candidates applying on the basis of NEET PG 2025 should fulfil the eligibility criteria for being granted admissions, as fixed under NEET PG 2025.
	vii. In case of tie between two or more candidates having equal marks, the inter se ranking of successful candidates will be based on NEET PG 2025 Rank.
	viii. The choice of course/ specialty/ Institution (District Civil Hospital/Government Medical College) shall be filled by the candidate on the online web portal. The choices of course/ specialty/institution in the order of preferences given by the candidate shall be considered final.
	ix. The allotment of course/specialty/institution shall be strictly made as per the merit prepared on the basis of merit of NEET-PG-2025 for Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses and the choice/preference of the course/specialty/ Institution filled up by the in-service doctor on the online portal shall be taken as final.
	x. However, the online counselling result shall be provisional and final confirmation of seats and allotment of institution shall be done by the Admission Committee after physical verification of eligibility and original documents.
	<p>xi. The In-service doctors, who have been provisionally allocated seats, will have to appear in person for document verification (with all original documents) before the Admission Committee at Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.</p> <p>Online provisional allocation of the seat/institute shall give no legal right to the candidate for the said seat and the seat shall be confirmed only after document verification as per notified specific time period. Similarly, deposition of tuition fee/any other fee shall not confer any legal right towards the provisionally allotted seat. The Admission Committee reserves the right to cancel the provisional allocation of seat allotted to the in-service doctor in case of incomplete / invalid documents.</p>
	<p>xii. The Admission Committee shall include :—</p> <p>The Admission Committee constituted by Department of Medical Education & Research for MD/MS courses and Civil Surgeons of respective NBE accredited hospitals as members for Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses.</p>

	xiii. The Admission Committee will be responsible for taking decision for admission related matters has supervision of admission related web portal, conduct of counselling, document verification and allocation of seats in accordance with the Government policies and existing Rules and Regulations. Further, the Admission Committee is empowered to take decision in all admission related disputes.												
	xiv. The Director General Health Services/Director Medical Education & Research, Haryana as the case may be, shall be the Appellate Authority for the decisions taken by the Admission Committee in case of in-service candidates for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses. All rules and regulations of counselling and admission process as specified by department of MER will be applicable and followed as such.												
	xv. Final number of seats in each specialty under each category and in each District Civil Hospital/ Government Medical College will be available on the website of Pandit Bhagwat Dayal University of Health Sciences, Rohtak i.e www.uhsr.ac.in and admission web portal. The candidates will be duty bound to regularly visit the website for updates.												
	xvi. However, if the seats for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses still remain vacant, even after two rounds of counselling, then left over vacant seats will be filled up as per directions of NBE/MoHFW (GOI) and as per procedure notified by the State Government.												
	xvii. All Rules/Guidelines pertaining to last date of admission/joining for each round/payment of security fee/eligibility for each round/process of counselling etc. as mandated by Department of Medical Education and Research for admission to MD/MS Courses shall be applicable for admission to Post MBBS DNB/Post MBBS Diploma Courses as well.												
9.	<p>Fee Structure:</p> <p>i. Library fee: Library fee shall cover the provisions made by the hospital for subscription of journals and purchase of textbooks for trainees. Annual Appraisal fees: The appraisal fees shall cover the arrangements made for the purpose of appraisal of trainees and examiner remuneration. Accommodation Charges: Electricity and other consumables can be charged on actual basis by the hospital depending upon institutional policy. The accommodation charges cannot be levied if the accredited hospital is not providing accommodation to the trainees. <p>ii. The fee shall be payable on annual basis.</p> <p>iii. The fee for the first year course shall be deposited by successful In-service candidate with Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak. The fee shall be transferred to the respective District Civil Hospital/Government Medical College by the Chairman, Admission Committee, within a month, after completion of Admission process.</p> <p>iv. The fee shall be refunded/adjusted, if an In-service candidate is shifted in subsequent counselling from one institute to another only as per NBE guidelines.</p> <p>v. In case of request for withdrawal of admission by an In-service candidate, the fee shall be refunded to that candidate, only if, the request is made in person along the original receipt of fee deposition at least 03 days prior to the last date prescribed for admission to Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses only as per NBE guidelines. 	<p>vi. In-service doctors are advised to mandatorily provide their email ID and mobile number to receive all the regular updates.</p> <p>Note.—Any amendments by NBE/ MoHFW/ State Government shall have a binding on any provisions contained in this notification.</p>
10.	The service bond/conditions, as notified by the State Government in PG Policy, shall be applicable for in- service doctors persuing Post MBBS DNB and Post MBBS Diploma courses and amended from time to time.
11.	<p>General Instructions:-</p> <p>a. List of documents to be brought at the time of document verification is at Annexure- ‘A’.</p> <p>b. Admitted In-service doctors shall pay the fees and other charges, as per para 9 mentioned above.</p> <p>c. All In-service doctors belonging to the Scheduled Castes/PWD/ESM/FF category must submit a certificate in the prescribed format issued from the Competent Authority of the State Government.</p> <p>d. Reservation to the SC category of In-service doctors will be followed as per Haryana Government notification dated 15.05.2020 and amended time to time.</p> <p>e. The eligibility criteria for admission to backward classes i.e., BC(A) and BC(B) shall be as per Haryana Government Notification dated 16.07.2024 and any amendments thereof.</p> <p>f. Dependents of Freedom Fighters (FF) who wish to be considered for reservation as such, must submit a certificate from the Competent Authority along with undertaking.</p> <p>g. The reservation to Ex-servicemen and their wards will be considered as per notification of Haryana Government, General Services III branch No. 22/10/2013- 1 GSIII dated 10.08.2017 and amended time to time.</p> <p>h. A candidate from reserved category shall have the right to compete for admission in General/Unreserved category, seats as per his/her merit. In case, a candidate does not fill up his reserve category in his application form, he/she will not be subsequently considered for admission against that category. However, if a reserved category candidate has availed of any concession, such as relaxation in upper age limit, qualification or permitted number of chances in written examination etc., then he/she cannot be considered against General/Un-reserved seats.</p> <p>i. The admission shall be made to only those institutions/District Civil Hospitals, which are recognized/approved/accredited for admission by National Board of Examinations.</p> <p>j. Any In-service candidate, if found to have submitted any false document/claim benefit of reservation shall be liable for penal action and his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately. Further, he/she shall be debarred for admission in future and necessary institutional disciplinary action shall be taken.</p>
12.	Any amendment by MOHFW/NMC/NBEMS/State Govt./Pt. B. D. Sharma UHS Rohtak shall be binding to the above clauses of notification.

Annexure 'A'**List of documents to be brought at the time of reporting before Admission Committee:**

The candidates, at the time of reporting must bring the following Original Certificates/ Documents alongwith two sets of duly self attested photocopies of these with them.

- 1) Matriculation Certificate/ High School Certificate/ICSE/Class X or its equivalent certificate as proof of date of birth.
- 2) Certificates of having passed MBBS examination from Institution recognized by MCI/NMC.
- 3) Three copies of the recent photographs (passport size) self attested used for NEET form.
- 4) Internship completion certificate certifying the date on which the candidate has completed one year Compulsory Rotatory Internship. The date of completion of internship training shall as notified by MoHFW/ NMC.
- 5) Foreign Medical Graduate Exam result (if applicable).
- 6) Character certificate of the Head of Institution last attended/First Class Executive Magistrate.
- 7) Resident certificate issued by competent authority of the State Government of Haryana (bona-fide resident certificate issued by competent authority of the State Government (if applicable).
- 8) Certificate of Registration with any State Medical Council/NMC at the time of counselling.
- 9) Caste Certificate issued by competent authority of the Haryana State Government (if applicable).
- 10) Certificate of Dependent of Fighter Certificate issued by competent authority of the Haryana State Government (if applicable).
- 11) Certificate of ESM issued by competent authority of the Haryana State Government (if applicable).
- 12) Income and Asset Certificate for EWS candidates issued by competent authority.
- 13) Certificate of Disability issued by notified centres by NBE or Medical Board at PGIMS, Rohtak (if applicable).
- 14) Result Card of NEET – PG 2025.
- 15) In-service category candidates must produce valid NOC issued by the competent authority failing which the In-service candidate shall be considered ineligible for counselling and for reservation under In-service category seats.
- 16) As Proof of identification Aadhaar card/PAN Card/Driving license/Passport/Voter ID/Ration Card/ Parivar Pehcahan Patre.
- 17) Printout of Application form.

Note:

Any candidate failing to bring original documents at the time of document verification/counselling will not be considered and his/her claim to admission will be forfeited.
